Kailua Assembly Instructions

Parts List -

Cage:

- 2 dowel perches
- 1 plastic base with removable tray
- 2 stainless steel bowls with rings and attached brackets and wing nuts
- 2 pairs of panels (each consisting of one side and either a front or rear panel)
- 1 top piece (with opening doors)
- 1 grate
- 1 locking pole (insert through loops once main door is closed and swinging clip in place)

Optional stand:

- 4 casters
- 8 bolts and nuts
- 2 leg frames
- 2 side frames
- 1 shelf

1 - Assemble the cage by unfolding the panel pairs and connecting to the opposing pair. You may have to spread the hooked ends to fit over the vertical bars on the opposing panel. Once both pairs are connected, crimp the hooked ends tight (use a pair of pliers and a cloth to avoid scratching the hooked ends).

2 - Install the top by hooking to the top of each side panel using the tabs on the sides of the top piece. The top of the front and rear panels should be inside the front and rear edge of the top.

3 - Attach the feeder rings to the side panels directly below the slide up feeder doors using brackets and wing nuts already installed on the feeder ring bracket.

4 - Install grate on top of tray in base (this does not slide out, but rather, lifts out).

5 - Install the cage to the base by fitting tabs on the bottom of each side panel into the slots on the base. Tilt cage to one side and install the lower side first. Then lower other side and depress against side panel until tabs fit in the slots in the base on the other side. To remove, simply reverse procedure.

5 - Install main dowel(s) in interior and be sure at least one dowel provides access to feeders.

6 - Open top perch assembly. To open top doors, move sliding latches towards the side panels. Then lift doors to the open position. Install perch THROUGH each loop brackets on the top of doors and place the slotted end of the perch through the bar of the top. You may bend the loop brackets so that it rests tightly against the perch (do this before reinserting perch).

7 - Optional stand assembly. Bolts together the front, rear, and side pieces but leave bolts loose. Install shelf in the holes on the bottom horizontal beam of the front and rear pieces. Then tighten bolts. Casters bolt in to the legs on the front and rear pieces.

8 - Please cage inside stand.
